FOREST CLOSURE ORDERS IN PLACE:

Forest Road 085- Forest RD 085 from Tibble Fork area to Forest Lake- Closed to all Motorized use. Closed for public safety due to road damage. Large sluff at the Narrows rendering road unsafe to pass.

Lower Mill Trail- TR040- Lower Mill Trail to the Mudd Springs Trail junction- TR178. Closed to all Motorized use until September 1, 2023. Closed for public safety due to trail damage.

Forest Order- No camping or fires are allowed ¼ mile from median of SR92 and FR144 up American Fork Canyon. This order is in effect year round. Camping and fires allowed in designated day use, dispersed campsites and campgrounds only.

Forest Order- No camping or fires are allowed ¼ mile around Tibble Fork and Silver Lake Reservoirs. This order is in effect year round. Camping and fires allowed in designated day use, dispersed campsites and campgrounds only.

Trail Information and Descriptions:

* Damage occurring on trails and roads while wet are sometimes not able to be repaired. Help keep trails and roads in good condition for future use.

Safety:

- Please do not block gates or roadways, emergency vehicles must always have safe access to respond to an emergency.
- If your trailhead or parking lot is full, always have a backup plan and visit an alternate location for the day. Do not park in a no-parking zone, roadway or lane of travel, even in the back country/ dirt roads.
- No Fireworks Allowed on National Forest System Lands.
- Safety is everyone's responsibility. Please do your part.

Garbage:

- Take garbage out of the canyon. Sites, other than campgrounds do not have large dumpsters due to them attracting animals into public spaces, smell and taking up valuable parking. Be a good Land Steward and help keep the forest clean.

Pass Sales:

- Pleasant Grove Ranger District Office lobby is now open M-F 0800-1630.
- Passes are also available at the American Fork and Aspen Grove Information Stations.

America the Beautiful Passes

Passes are available at US Forest Service Information Stations, offices and National Park Service Visitor Centers. You can purchase the following:

- Annual passes, annual or lifetime Senior passes, Access pass, 4th grade pass, annual (active duty) or lifetime Military (honorably discharged veterans & Gold Star Family) passes .

Canyon passes may be purchased in advance at www.recreation.gov/sitepass/U-W-C or by scanning the QR code, or by stopping by the Forest Service office or Information Stations located at either end of the Alpine Loop.

Valid pass must be on display in your vehicle.



PERMIT SYSTEM FOR TIMPONEEKE TRAILHEAD GO INTO EFFECT THIS SEASON

Timed tickets will be available for on Rec.gov June 7- 10EST -

Timed tickets will be required to occupy the Timponeeke Trailhead Fee site **July 7-October 15** on peak days and during peak hours.

- Permits are required on peak days, Fridays, Saturdays and Holidays from midnight to 1:00 pm, which will help reduce congestion in the parking area. Example: Friday night 12:00 am to Saturday 1:00 pm. Saturday night 12:00 am to Sunday 1:00 pm.
- Cost for the permit is the existing day use fee \$6.00, plus \$2.00 non-refundable reservation fee. Current access passes can be used to reserve permit.
- The permit will be a timed ticket that will be required to be displayed in vehicle.
- Compliance Officers will be on-site during peak hours.
