Trail Facts

Directions to the Trailhead:

From Telluride, drive 6 miles west on State Hwy 145. Turn left onto the Silver Pick Road (CR 60M). Proceed for 4.0 miles to the intersection of County Roads 60M and 59H. Turn right onto CR 59H and proceed south for 2.3 miles. Turn right at Rock of Ages sign onto FSR 645. Proceed for 2.2 miles to the Rock of Ages Trailhead.

Note: FSR 622 and 645 are not maintained for passenger vehicles.

Camping:

Camping is prohibited at the trailhead to protect adjacent meadow habitat.

However, visitors can camp on National Forest lands along FSR 622 and 645.

The trail is open to horse and foot travel (Note: Horses are prohibited on the trail segment that crosses private land in Silver Pick Basin. See map).

Trail Length:

- 3.7 miles to Rock of Ages Saddle
- 4.3 miles to Wilson Peak summit

Elevation:

- 10,383 feet at trailhead
- 13,400 feet at Rock of Ages Saddle
- 14,017 feet at Wilson Peak summit
