





Reducing Wildfire Risk Across Southern California




MAINTAINED FUELBREAK

Areas without woody plants along ridgelines, roads, or powerlines give firefighters a safe place to put fires out before they spread into or out of communities.



MOUNTAINTOP FORESTS



Remove some trees and shrubs and burn regularly to be healthy.



HARDENED HOME


PROTECT YOUR HOME

With fire-resistant materials, screened vents.




HEALTHY SHRUBLANDS AND FORESTS

Provide clean water, recreation, scenery, carbon storage, and wildlife habitat.




DEFENSIBLE SPACE
