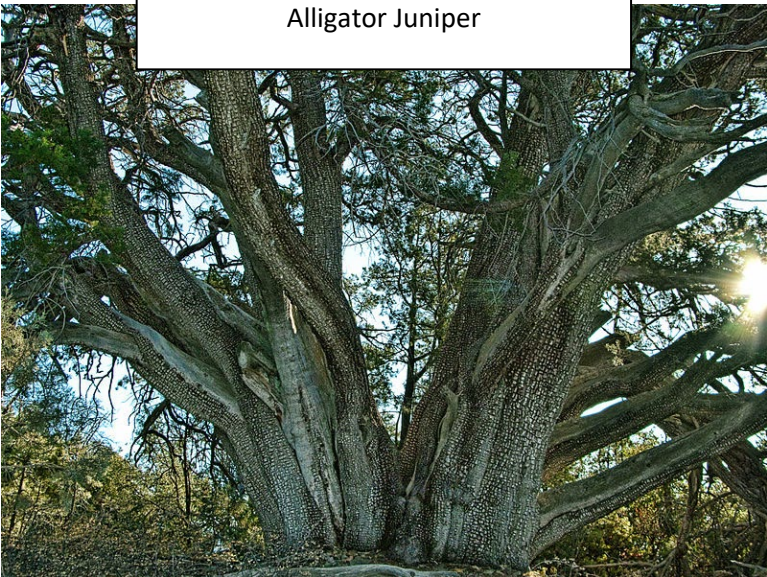

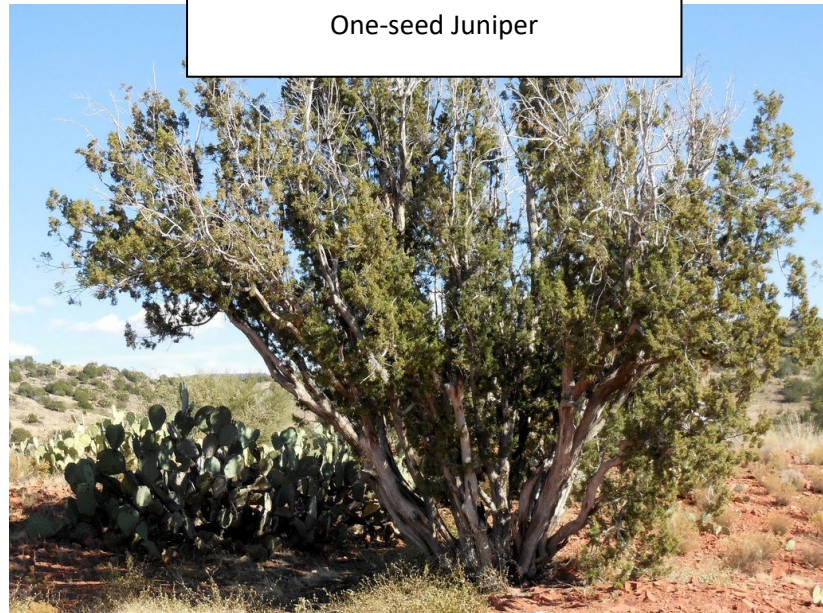

# Softwood Species

These species include various pines, fir, and Douglas-fir. Below are some examples of what they could look like while alive. Collection is limited to **dead and down** (no diameter limit) and **dead standing up to 9 inches in diameter measured at 4.5 feet up from the ground.** **DO NOT CUT LIVE TREES OR LIMBS.**
