



# White River National Forest Final Travel Management Plan Summer - Alternative F

Notes:

Summer travel period begins May 21 at 00:00 and ends November 22 at 23:59. All motorized and mechanized modes of travel must be on designated routes. All motorized categories generally allow mechanized modes of travel (bicycle), animal (horse), and foot (hike) unless otherwise specified. All mechanized will allow animal (horse) and foot (hike) unless otherwise specified. Animal (horse) and foot (hike) are allowed to travel across country and generally on all routes. There are some routes that limit animal (horse) use for safety reasons. There may be some routes that are specific to a particular use only that does not fit the standard use categories. These and other exceptions will be specifically noted in a separate table.

"Other Public Roads/Trails" are closed to unlicensed motorized vehicles.

"Ski Area Permitted Lands" contain additional roads and trails that are dedicated to and administered by the individual ski areas. Public access to these routes is available by permission only from the ski areas.

Due to map scale, all route numbers are not displayed and some routes may be difficult to distinguish. This map is not intended to be used for navigation.

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
