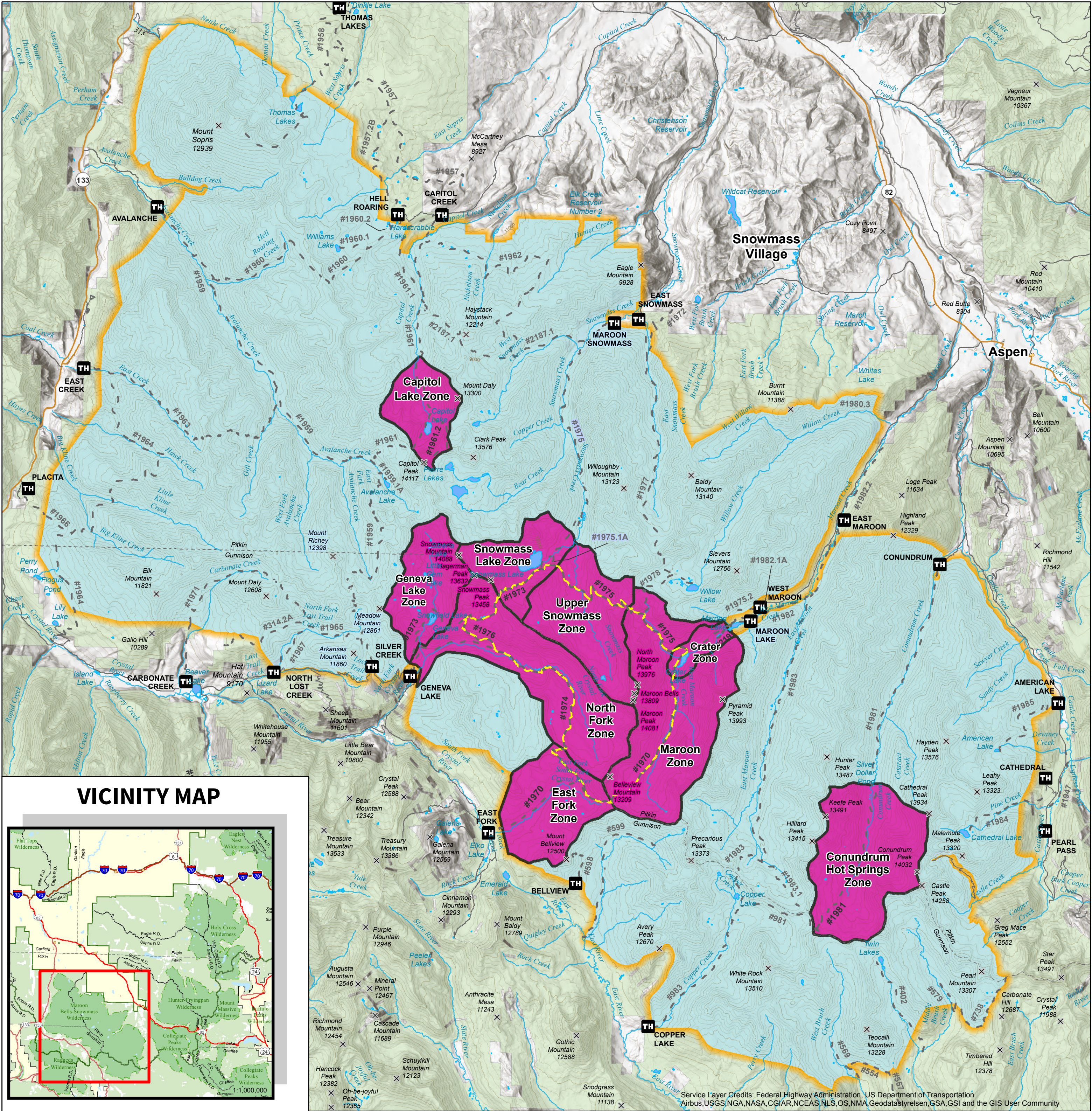


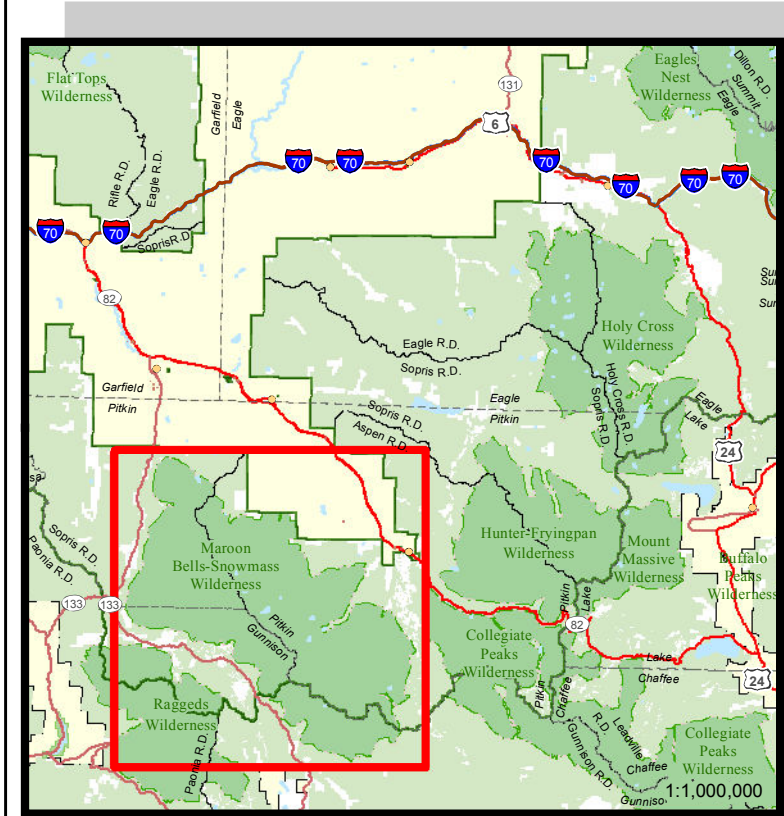


MAROON BELLS-SNOWMASS WILDERNESS OVERNIGHT PERMIT ZONE MAP
