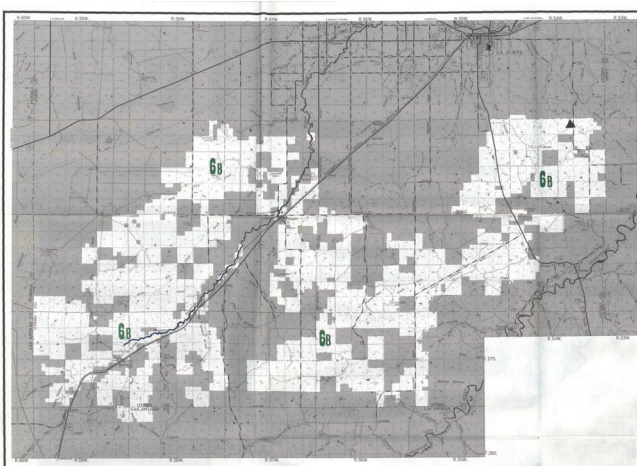




MANAGEMENT AREA

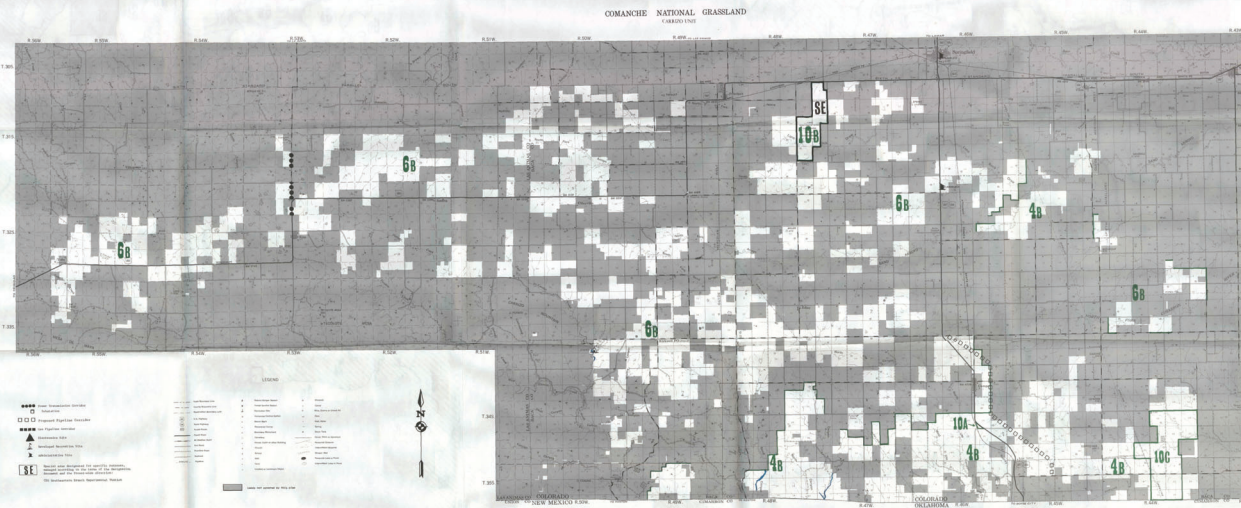
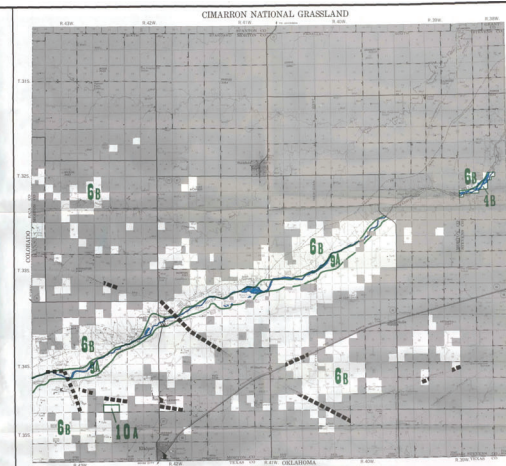
6a Management Area 6a is located in the northwestern portion of the Comanche National Grassland. It is a large, irregularly shaped area that includes the towns of Lawton and Lawtonville. The area is primarily composed of private land, with some public land interspersed.
