HIGH VALLEY BYPASS TRAIL #391

GENERAL INFORMATION: High Valley Bypass Trail #391 begins at Copper Basin Road and crosses Aspen Creek before continuing uphill through ponderosa pine forest. The pines are replaced by oak and a variety of shrubs and wildflowers where past fires cleared much of the timber. These open areas reveal the lay of the land—rolling hillsides that fold in on one another like accordion ridges. Visitors who take advantage of the quiet morning and evening hours are likely to spot wildlife. Deer are common, as well as a stunning assembly of birds that includes swallows, acorn woodpeckers, and northern flickers, spotted towhees and juncos. TR 391 ends at Potts Creek Trail #327. Take this trail south towards Aspen Creek Trailhead (via Cold Springs Trail #393), or north towards Thumb Butte.

CAUTION: This trail is open to hikers, horseback riders and mountain bicyclists. Please be considerate of others—slow down and know when to yield the trail.

ACCESS AND TRAILHEAD LOCATION: From its intersection with White Spar Road, travel west on Copper Basin Road for 3 miles to where the pavement ends. TR 391 begins on the right. There is no parking area.

TRAVEL TIME: 15 minutes from Prescott

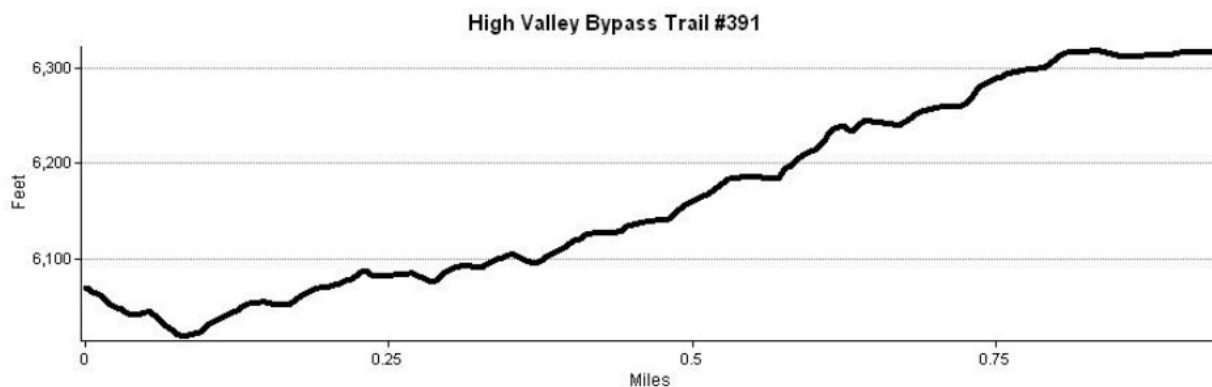
ROAD CONDITIONS: Suitable for all vehicles

HIKING TIME: 20 minutes, one way **LENGTH:** 0.9 miles **DIFFICULTY:** Moderate **USE:** Moderate

NOTES: This trail is open to hikers, horseback riders, and mountain bicyclists. Please be considerate of other users—slow down and know when to yield the trail. Refrain from using horses and bikes when the trail is wet. TR 391 is adjacent to private property. Please respect landowners and obey all posted signs.

RECOMMENDED SEASONS OF USE: Spring, summer, fall, winter
