

# MOTOR VEHICLE USE MAP

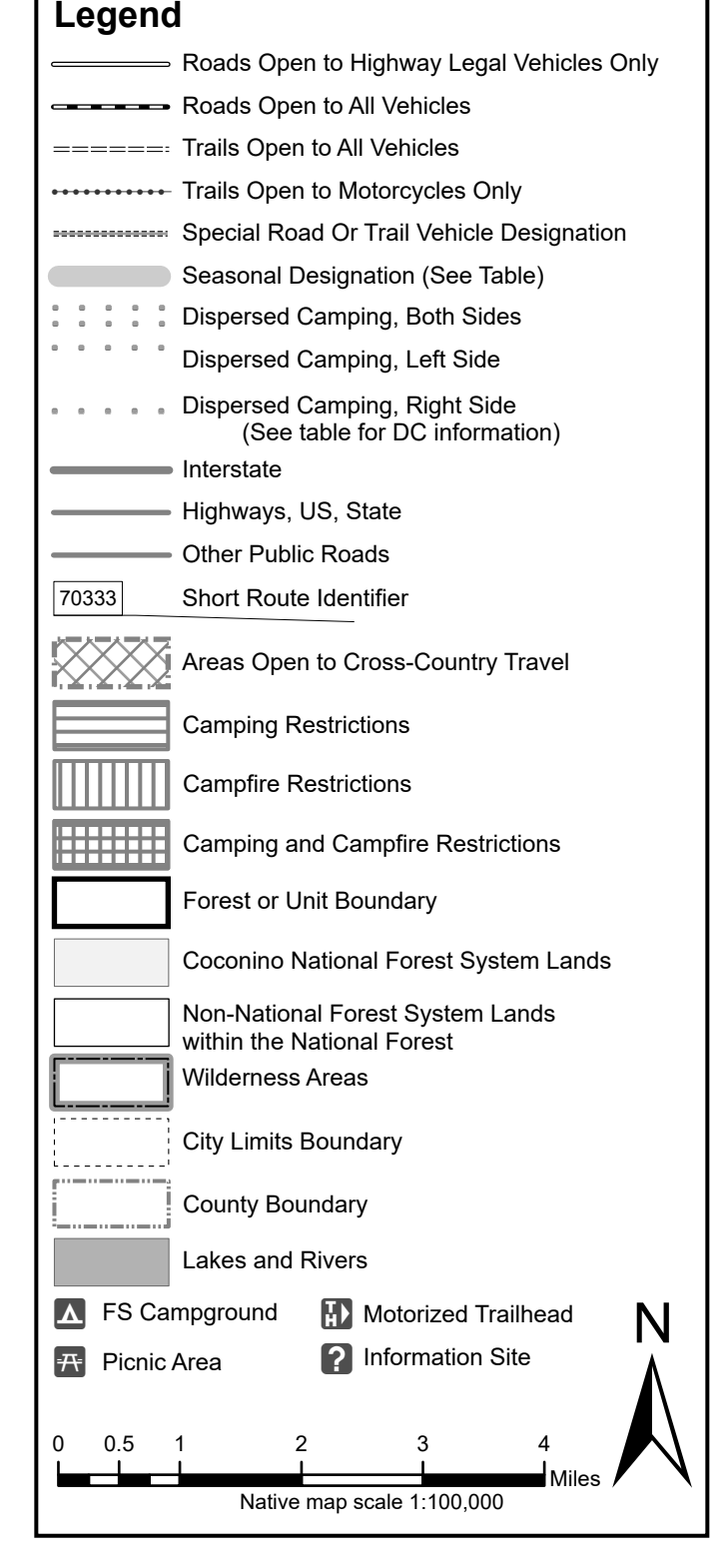
The designations shown on this motor vehicle use map (MVUM) were made by the responsible official pursuant to 36 CFR 212.51, are effective as of the date on the front cover of this MVUM, and will remain in effect until superseded by next year's MVUM.

It is the responsibility of the user to acquire the current MVUM. This MVUM shows the National Forest System roads, National Forest System trails, and the areas on National Forest System lands in the Coconino National Forest that are designated for motor vehicle use pursuant to 36 CFR 212.51. This MVUM also identifies the vehicle classes allowed on each route and in each area, and any seasonal designations that apply on those routes and in those areas.

Designation of a road, trail, or area for motor vehicle use by a particular class of vehicle under 36 CFR 212.51 should not be interpreted as encouraging or inviting use or implying that the road, trail, or area is open to motor vehicle use at all times or for all vehicles. Motor vehicle designations include parking along designated routes and at facilities associated with designated routes when it is safe to do so and when not causing damage to National Forest System lands. Seasonal weather conditions and natural events may render designated roads and trails impassable for extended periods. Designated areas may contain dangerous or impassable terrain. Many designated roads and trails may be impassible only when clearance vehicles or four-wheel-drive vehicles. Maintenance of designated roads and trails will depend on available resources, and many may receive little maintenance.

This motor vehicle use map identifies those roads, trails, and areas designated for the motor vehicle use under 36 CFR 212.51 for the purpose of enforcing the prohibition in 36 CFR 261.13. This is a limited purpose. The other public roads are shown for information and navigation purposes only and are not subject to designation under the Forest Service travel management regulation.

These designations apply only to National Forest System roads, National Forest System trails, and areas on National Forest System lands.



## SPECIAL NOTICES

1. Areas open to Cross-Country Motorized Uses - The Center Hills OHV Area (located in the North Half of the MVUM) is open to all motor vehicles year-round. There are no other areas on the Forest with this designation.

2. Camping - Motor vehicle use for the purpose of dispersed camping is permitted only on National Forest System lands within 300 feet of the edge of road segments with dispersed camping. Visitors may park along the edge of any designated route at any location on National Forest System lands, except where specifically prohibited. Designated locations include all lands within the city limits of Flagstaff and Sedona. Areas where camping and/or campfires have been restricted or prohibited under a Forest Order have been designated on this map. Visit <http://fs.usda.gov/ovhc> for a complete list and additional information on current Forest Orders and area restrictions. Remember to park vehicles just off of the traveled portion of roadways to permit the safe passage of through traffic.

3. Elk retrieval - When an elk has been legally taken in Game Management Units SA, 06, 7E, 7W, and the individual who legally took the animal may drive, or be driven to, the collection area. Under no circumstances shall a second vehicle be used to retrieve the animal. The vehicle used to transport the elk may be operated off of designated routes on non-wilderness National Forest System lands up to one mile from designated routes in areas not closed to motor vehicle use under Forest Closure Orders, and in a manner that does not result in unacceptable resource damage under 36 CFR Part 261. In addition, information on Forest Closure Orders will be available at all Coconino National Forest offices during elk hunting season. Motor vehicle use of off-designated routes is not allowed for game retrieval of any species, including elk, in game management units SA, 5B5, 5B6, or 11.

4. Roads in developed compounds and other developed areas - All roads in developed compounds are designated for highway legal vehicles only. Other developed sites, such as surfaced parking areas, developed dispersed campsites (includes ground surfacing and signage), and trailheads may be accessed by vehicles even when not shown on this map.

5. Seasonal areas - Motor vehicle use of a forest road or trail for purposes of camping or game retrieval shall not cross riparian areas, streams, and rivers except at gated crossings with existing culverts. Motor vehicle use off of a forest road or trail may occur at any time, right or both sides of the route, and signed as closed even if shown as designated on the map.

6. Canyon Mountain Trail - Canyon Mountain Trail (Trail No. 8) is designated as a motorized trail with very rugged conditions along a narrow ridge with limited opportunity for two-way traffic. For vehicles 102" or wider, the route is open year-round and no permit is required; there is a room to go around existing gates at each crossing. For vehicles over 102" or wider, few permits are available for this route through mid-October each year. No more than one permit will be issued per calendar week.

7. Designated roads are subject to wet weather or winter road closures, or may be temporarily closed due to seasonal conditions, project related work, emergency activities, or firefighting operations. Roads designated on this map are available for motorized use as depicted except when posted as being unavailable for use or when a sign or other administrative or public safety notice. Winter weather closures generally occur in the winter months, and can last until mid-April. Please refer to the National Forest web page for the latest information about status of roads.

## PROHIBITIONS

It is prohibited to possess or operate a motor vehicle on National Forest System lands on the Coconino National Forest other than in accordance with these designations (36 CFR 212.51).

Violators of 36 CFR 261.13 are subject to a fine of up to \$5,000, imprisonment for up to 6 months, or both (18 U.S.C. 371(b)). This prohibition applies regardless of the presence or absence of signs.

This map does not display nonmotorized uses, over-snow uses, or other facilities and restrictions on the Coconino National Forest. Obtain forest visitor information from the local national forest office.

Designated roads, trails and areas may also be subject to temporary, emergency closures. As a visitor, you must comply with signs notifying you of such restrictions. A national forest may issue an order to close a road, trail or area on a temporary basis to protect the life, health, or safety of forest visitors or the natural or cultural resources in those areas. Such temporary and/or emergency closures are consistent with the Travel Management Rules (36 CFR 212.51 (b), 36 CFR 261 subpart B).

The designation "road or trail open to all motor vehicles" does not supersede State traffic law.

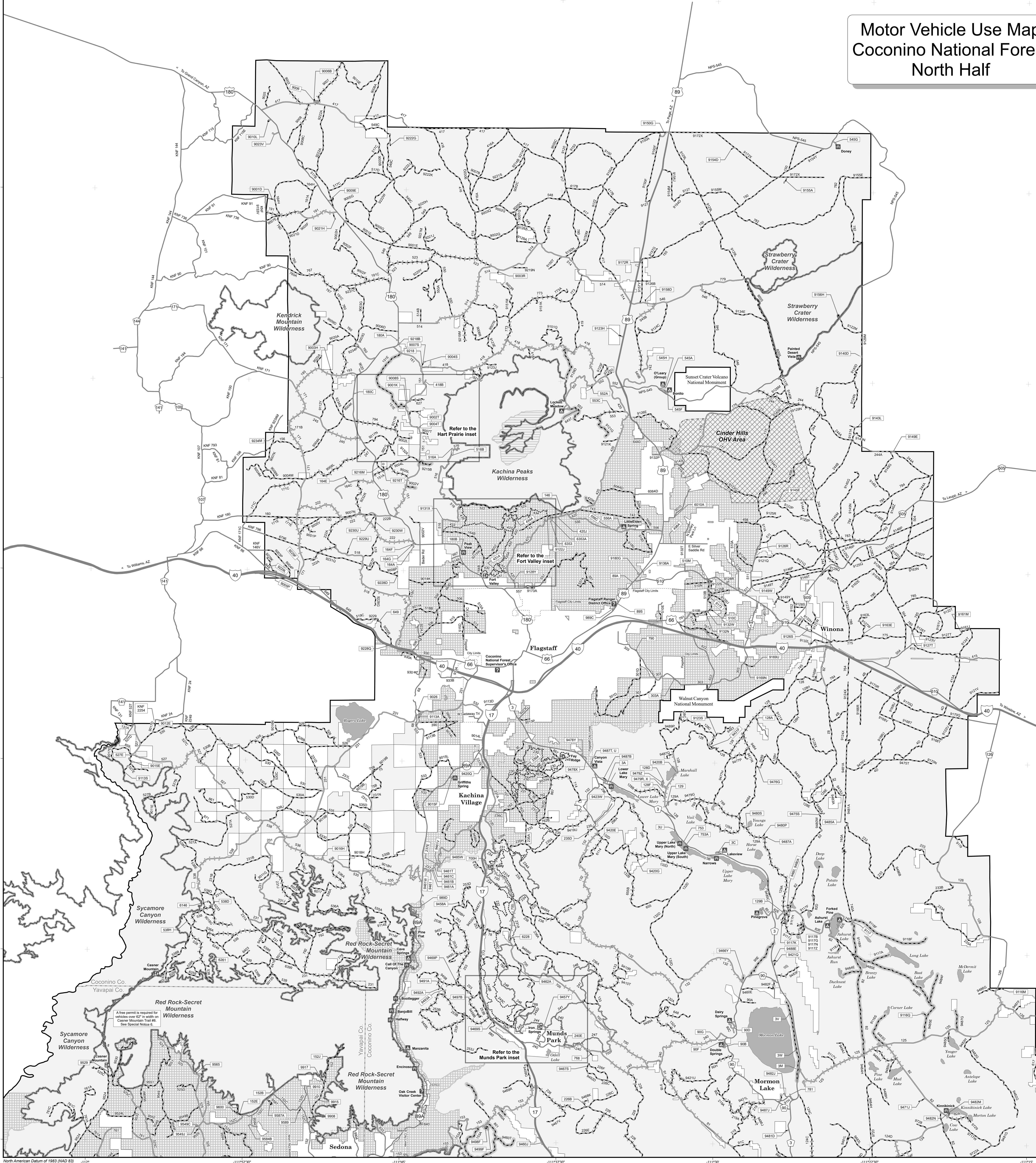
