I. TRACKING INFORMATION. Completed by Resource Support Section or Operations staff. Required for all requests.

State: If multi-State, choose State most likely to receive resource(s), (i.e., when using 7220-SU Program Code)

Resource Request No.: Based on chronological log number. Used for tracking.

<u>Program Code/Event No.:</u> The pre-declaration, emergency, or major disaster number assigned for funding the event. Examples: 7220-SU, 3130-EM, 1248-DR.

II. ASSISTANCE REQUESTED. Completed by requestor.

<u>Assistance Requested:</u> Details from the Resource Request Form will provide information concerning the assistance requested. Internal Control No.: Internal requestor reference, log, or control number, if applicable.

<u>Initiator/Requestor</u>: The initiator may be an individual filling out the mission assignment and making a request on behalf of the POC. POC Name: The person coordinating reception and utilization of the requested resources. 24-hour contact information required.

III. INITIAL FEDERAL COORDINATION. Completed by FEMA Personnel with Delegated Authority.

Additional Statement of Work

Initial request for resources are for Gunnison County EOC, to include one (1) Federal Support OPS3, and one (1) Federal Support Technical

Specialist.
AS authorized by FEMA, USFS will provide planning, communication and coordination support to county/state level Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in the state of Colorado. Personnel assigned must be 1) able to work virtually, or 2) can drive to and from the assigned location without needing to stop overnight in order to remain in compliance with the Standards for Interagency Incident Business Practices.

Utilize USFS, DOI, other Federal agency and State/local resources under existing agreement, as appropriate.

- a. MA task orders may be issued by FEMA for specific requirements, personnel, location(s), date(s), and duration of assignment(s).
- b. Agencies will be reimbursed for all eligible expenses pursuant to 44 CFR. Supporting documentation is required for reimbursement.
- c. All equipment and supply purchases must be coordinated with a FEMA Project Manager. If approved, documentation is necessary to ensure reimbursement. .
