Elk trunks provide educators (or agencies, scout leaders, RMEF volunteers, etc.) with an effective combination of tactile and written tools designed to teach youth about elk, other wildlife, habitat conservation and hunting. In urban settings, elk trunks offer youth a chance to see and touch elk country, encouraging them to care about the natural world even if it isn't part of their daily lives.
