

Umpqua Native Shrub Bird Enhancement

2006 Accomplishments

This project requested dollars to make collections of soft-fruit bearing shrubs for future outplanting projects to benefit songbirds. The work was accomplished during the summer of 2006 with a local contractor. Collections were made of all species originally listed in the project proposal with the exception of Pacific Madrone. We decided not to pursue this species because fruiting of Pacific Madrone can be highly unpredictable, and wild populations of the other proposed species were yielding heavily.

We received the following yields from our contractor:

Blue Elderberry	11 Bushels
Red Elderberry	5 Bushels
Cascade Mtn. Ash	6 Bushels
Bitter Cherry	5.3 Bushels
Black Huckleberry	1 Bushel
Pacific Serviceberry	1 Bushel
