2008 Accomplishments

Native Plant Materials Program

- Collected 5 grass species, 1 sedge and 3 forbs at three subalpine sites with Deane Little, owner of New Prairie Farm, local grower in Boulder, Colorado for increase and common garden studies.
- Collected 2 grass species with Wildland Restoration Volunteers at two montane sites.

Seed Collections:

- Collected a total of 31 accessions for seed increase.

Preparation for seed increase:

- Completed germination studies.
- Planted grasses and forbs for seed increase at New Prairie Farm.
- Seed sent to USFS Lucky Peak Nursery, Boise, Idaho for seed increase.
