2009 Native Plant Material Accomplishments

Foundation Seed Collection

Contract to collect foundation seed awarded and completed (Wildlands Inc.):

Bromus carinatus (Mountain brome) – 15 lb

Elymus glaucus (blue wildrye) - 20 lb

In-house collections of target species for sitespecific restoration and revegetation projects. Species include sedges and emergent grasses, forbs, and shrubs.

Collection of 2000+ live stakes of *Salix spp* (willows) and *Cornus sericea* (red-osier dogwood) for propagation of rooted cuttings for riparian plantings.

Native Seed Production

Contract awarded for grass seed production from foundation seed collections (Western Reclamation).

First harvest from two native grass seed production fields at J. Herbert Stone Nursery. These fields will be retained and harvested again in 2010.

Site-specific projects

Slab Camp Trailhead and Parking Area Reconfiguration – 450 native containerized plants produced by Sound Native Plants.

Integration with Invasive Plant program – revegetation planning for weed-infested bog and lakeshore.

Wet meadow complex adjacent to a road scheduled for decommissioning. Seed and cuttings of several species were collected from this site and will be used in the revegetation of the decommissioned roadbed.
