2009 Native Plant Program Accomplishments

### New contracts were awarded & funds obligated to produce:

- 300 lbs *Poa secunda* (Sandberg's bluegrass)
  300 lbs *Pseudoroegneria spicata* (bluebunch wheatgrass)

## Excess seed was purchased from production fields:

- Elymus elemoides (bottlebrush squirreltail) 90 lbs
- Deschampsia caespitosa (tufted hairgrass) 155 lbs
- Koleria cristata (prairie junegrass) 225 lbs
- Poa secunda (Sandberg's bluegrass) 250 lbs
- Pseudoroegneria spicata (bluebunch wheat grass) 580 lbs
- Elymus glaucus (blue wildrye) 600 lbs
- Bromus carinatus (mountain brome) • 1,000 lbs
- Festuca idahoensis (Idaho fescue) • 1,000 lbs

## Restoration Project Implementation:

Seed purchased in FY09 was either stored for future use or applied on a variety of restoration projects. About 1,880 lbs of seed were 'mixed' together from several species and broadcast onto approx 125 acres for restoration following:

- Road decommissioning
- •Timber sale use of landings and skid trails
- Stream rehabilitation and stabilization activities.

#### New foundation seed collections made:

- •5 lbs each of Koleria cristata & Acnatherum occidentalis were collected and now available on inventory for future seed increase production;
- •15 lbs of "forb mix" were collected to be sown directly onto future restoration project sites.
