2009 Native Plant Material Accomplishments

Funds were obligated to seed production and propagation contracts to produce:

- 2225 lbs *Elymus glaucus* (blue wildrye) seed
- 850 lbs Bromus carinatus (California brome) seed
- 666 lbs Deschampsia elongata (slender hairgrass) seed
- 290 lbs Festuca idahoensis (Idaho fescue) seed
- 12,500 Alnus rubra (red alder) seedlings
- 500 Physocarpus capitatus (ninebark) shrubs
- 1000 Acer macrophyllum (bigleaf maple) seedlings

Collection of foundation seed included:

- 0.3 lbs *Alnus rubra* (red alder)
- 61 lbs *Elymus glaucus* (blue wildrye)
- 19 lbs *Bromus carinatus* (California brome)
- 5 lbs Festuca idahoensis (Idaho fescue)

Monitoring of seeding projects to assess effectiveness related to methods of application, erosion control, weed control, and productivity of natives was begun in 2009. Projects moniteored included:

- Culvert replacements
- Landslides
- Landings and skid-trails in timber sales
- Fire line rehabilitation

Funds were also used for salaries to: manage the Forest's seed inventory; locate and map new source populations; test, clean, and store native seeds; develop and administer collection and production contracts; compile collection data into Forest-wide database; and attend COR training.
