## 2010 Accomplishments

Native pollinators play a pivotal role in our lives and natural ecosystems. At the Seeley Lake Ranger Station, we expanded the native plant garden and enhanced it for pollinators. We planted more than 40 species of native plants and provided logs and rocks as nesting habitat for pollinators.
