2010 Native Plant Material Accomplishments

New contracts were awarded and funds obligated to produce:

- 1,000 lbs. blue wildrye and 600 lbs. Roemers's fescue for Gold Beach R.D. by Pacific Northwest Natives
- 1200 lbs. California brome for High Cascades R.D. by Pacific Northwest Natives (funded with ARRA dollars)
- 500 lbs. of Roemer's fescue, and 300 lbs of Danthonia for Gold Beach R.D. by Benson Farms (funded with ARRA dollars)
- 1,500 plants from 5 rare plant species at Flora Pacifica in Brookings (funded with ARRA dollars)
- 1,700 plants from 8 shrub species at Clearwater Native Nursery (region-wide restoration services contract used)

2010 Seed production:

• 1,200 lbs of California brome (*Bromus carinatus*) produced by Pacific Northwest Natives

2010 Wild Collections:

- 5 lbs. Festuca roemeri, uncleaned (Gold Beach R.D.)
- 5 lbs. Elymus glaucus, uncleaned (Gold Beach R.D.)
- Also various amounts of Holodiscus discolor, Ceanothus thursiflorus, Ceanothus cuneatus, Rosa gymnocarpa, Sambucus nigra and Iliamna latibracteata were collected on Gold Beach R.D.
- 5 lbs. Sitanion hystrix, uncleaned (Siskiyou Mtns R.D.)
- Also a seed collection contract was awarded for tree, shrub and forb seed to be used in the Blue Ledge Mine restoration and toxic cleanup project on Siskiyou Mtns R.D.

Other Projects:

Roughly 100 acres were re-seeded post prescribed burn at Oak Flat and Shasta Costa Creek. Roughly 5 acres of road engineering projects were re-seeded, including 15 culvert replacements using seed grown and stored from previous years.
