

# Bitterroot National Forest Stevensville R.D. Pollinator Garden

## 2012 Accomplishments



The Stevensville Pollinator Garden received some wonderful additions during the 2012 season. In the spring, over 30 native plants were added to the beds to replace some that did not survive their first winter. Other fully mature plants were divided to produce new plants for other gardens. Hand crafted butterfly and bee boxes, produced by students at the Trapper Creek Job Corp, were added to the garden beds.

To enhance the public's experience of the garden, an interpretive panel was installed, showing the relationship between pollinators and native plants. Garden labels showing the scientific and common names of plants in the garden were also added.

Once again, the Stevensville Garden Club donated many member hours to the upkeep of the garden.
