

# Endangered, Threatened, and Proposed Species

## USDA Forest Service Eastern Region

Updated: May 30, 2012

The following species occur within the proclamation boundaries of at least one Eastern Region National Forest or Tallgrass Prairie. They are either **Proposed** for listing, or are listed as **Threatened** or **Endangered** under the Endangered Species Act.

### PLANTS

#### Endangered

- Shale-barren Rockcress (*Arabis serotina*) - MO
- Leafy Prairie-clover (*Dalea foliosa*) - MI
- Running Buffalo Clover (*Trifolium stoloniferum*) – MO, MT, WN

#### Threatened

- Mead's Milkweed (*Asclepias meadii*) – MI\*, MT, SH
- Hart's-tongue Fern (*Asplenium scolopendrium var. americanum*) - HI
- Pitcher's Thistle (*Cirsium pitcheri*) – HI, HM
- Virginia Sneezeweed (*Helenium virginicum*) - MT
- Dwarf Lake Iris (*Iris lacustris*) - HI
- Small Whorled Pogonia (*Isotria medeoloides*) – MO, WM
- Houghton's Goldenrod (*Oligoneuron houghtonii*) - HI
- Fassett's Locoweed (*Oxytropis campestris v. chartacea*) - CN
- Virginia Spirea (*Spiraea virginiana*) - MO
- Lakeside Daisy (*Tetraneuris herbacea (=Hymenoxys acaulis var. glabra)*) – HI
